

General Information for your stay at The Winter School

If you enter this post code in your sat nav BH21 4JH you should arrive at the rear entrance to Gaunts House, please park in the parking areas indicated and walk to the reception desk which will be located in the main entrance which is on the left about 100 yards straight up the drive.

There will be a Welcome talk for all arrivals at 20h30 on the first Friday, please attend.

Things to remember

Inside shoes / slippers are a requirement, a shoe bag may make life easier. We will install shelving in the Barn Theatre for storing dance shoes, etc. and a "mug board" so bring your favorite MUG !

Linen & bedding are supplied for those staying two or more nights, but **NOT** towels.

For those staying more than three days or camping there will be a wash and dry towel service so bring more than one !

Reusable drink bottles may be useful as they can easily be filled at the drinks station in the House.

There are tea making facilities in the bedrooms of the Stables & Apartments, kitchens in the Cottages & les Loges and a drinks station in the main House so please bring your favourite teas, coffee etc.

There will be the usual supply of free tea and real coffee in the House and Barn Theatre.

"Midnight Nibbles" will happen *comme d'habitude* but don't forget that extra bar of chocolate.

Torch, hot water bottle (just in cases).

Campers beware ! The outside shower block is unheated, the water's hot but that's your lot so you may need a warm dressing gown for when you brush your teeeeeeth.
